THE MOUNTAIN IN US – ANA BAIG

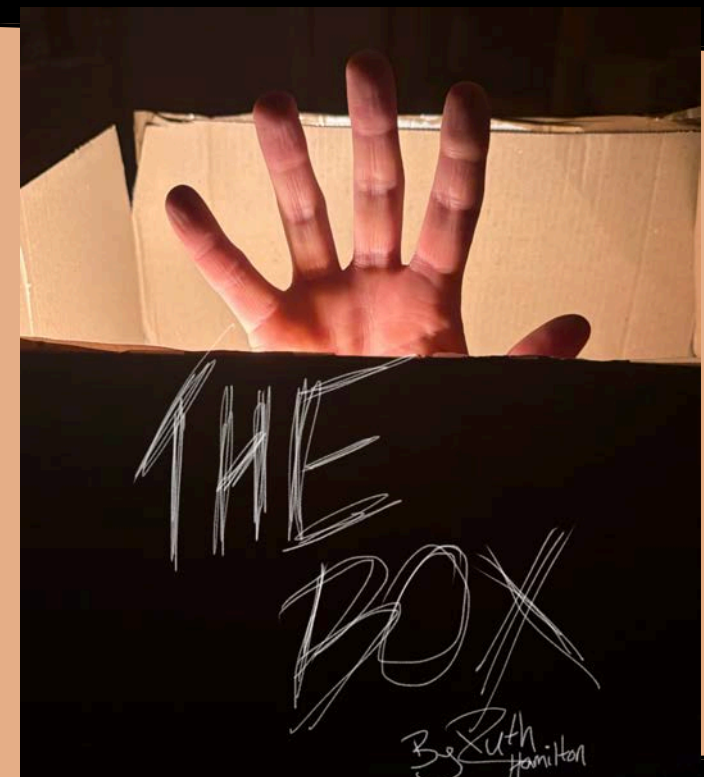
